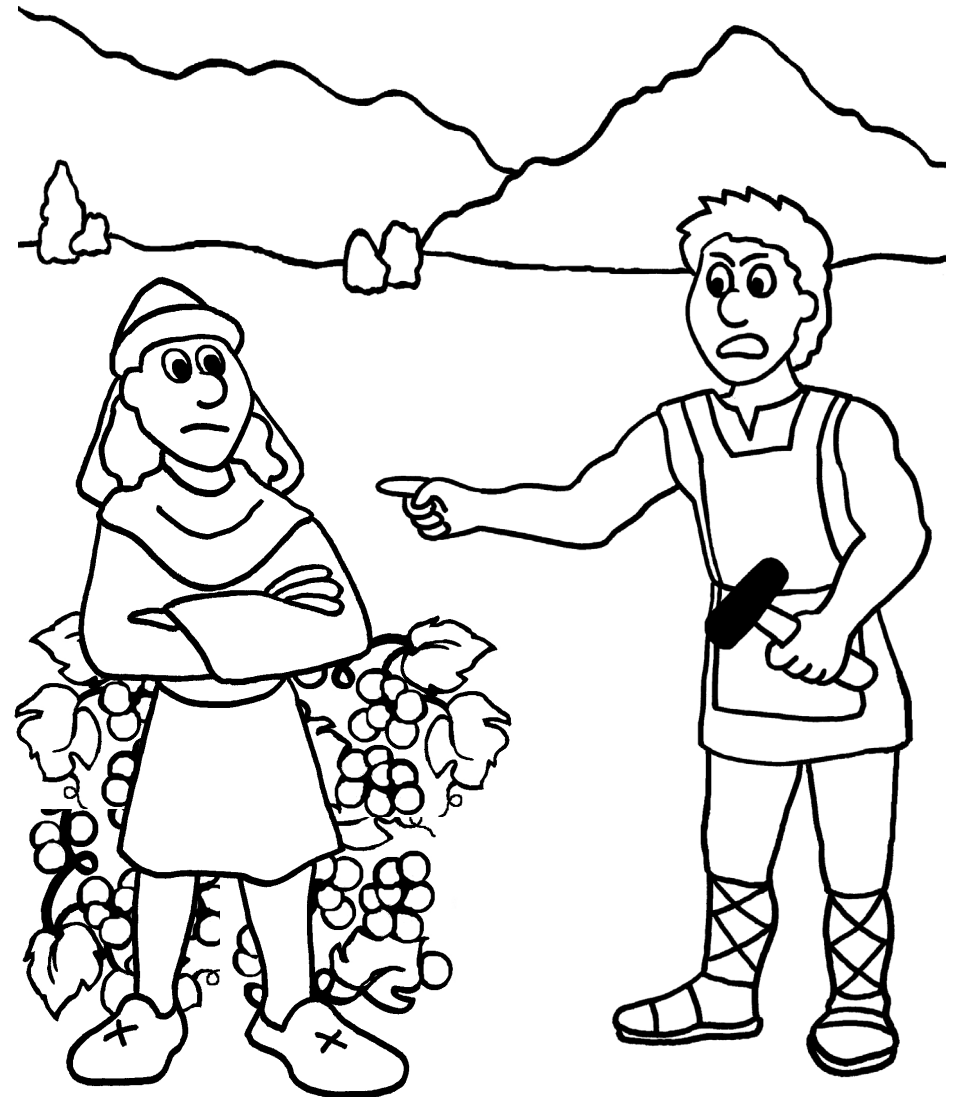

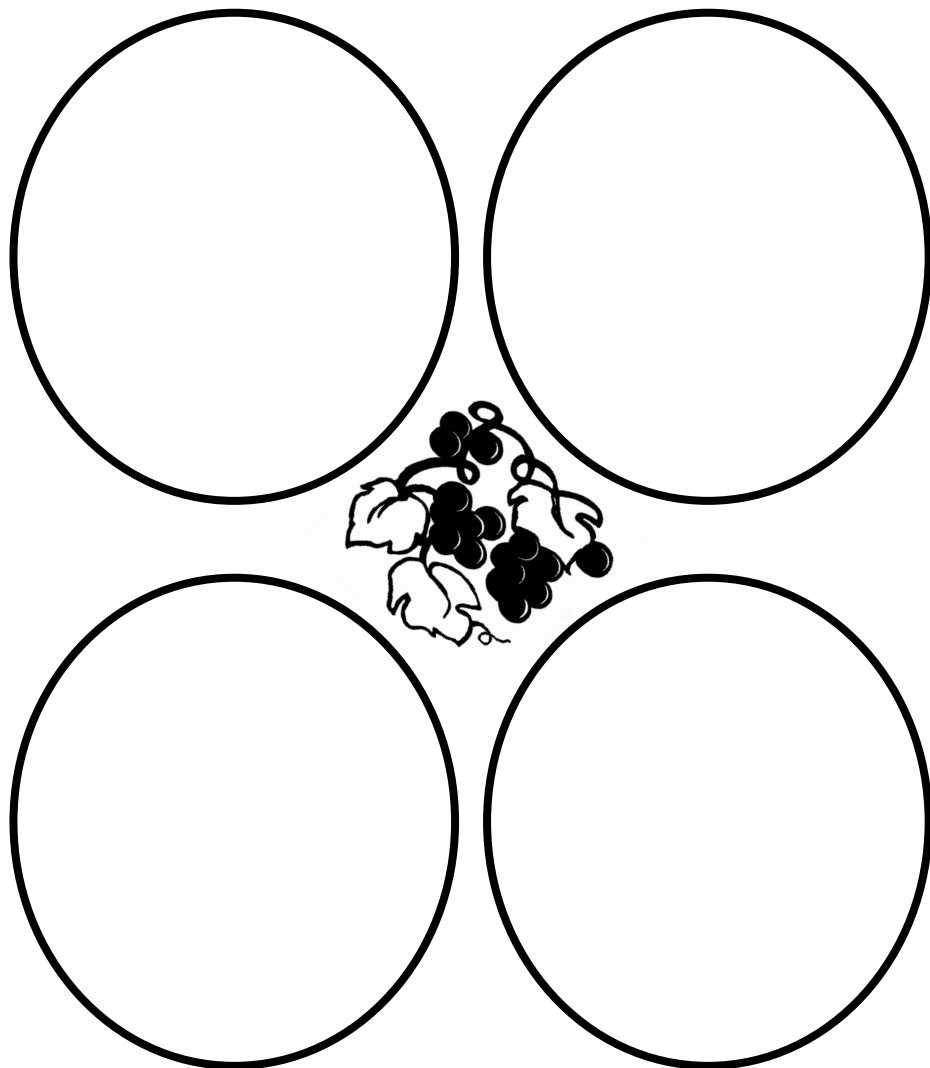
Some vineyard workers got very greedy.

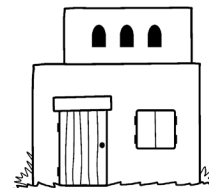
