Aids (pics, props, etc.)	Cups for kids to collect coins from the congregation.	
Message God always uses people just like you and me to get important jobs done. He used Isaiah to give the people messages. God would tell Isaiah what to tell the people about him and he would. He was like a Pastor who gives sermons. One time, after Isaiah had a dream or vision about God and some special angels with six wings, called seraphim, God had a job that needed to be done. He said, “Whom should I send to do this job? Who will go for us and do this job?” You know what Isaiah said? He said, “Here I am! Send me!” When God needed someone to do a job, Isaiah said, “Here I am! I’ll do it!” [Raise your hand and jump up and down with eagerness or something.] If God needed you to do a job, what would you say? “Here I am! Send me! I’ll do it!” If God asked you to take some cups around the church and collect some money, what would you say? Are you ready? [Pull some cups out and let them go.] [Depending on how big your congregation is, have the kids take cups (not Styrofoam) around for people to put change in. Have them put the money in a collection plate or take it up to the altar to give it to God. This could be done periodically to get coins or noisy nickels. It could go to a special charity: kids helping kids.] Let’s pray. <
