Message Throughout his life on earth, people would ask Jesus if he was the Christ, the Savior God promised to send them. He walked around teaching them about God and performing many miracles. [What are some of the miracles Jesus showed them? He helped blind people see, healed people of sickness and broken bodies, helped deaf people to hear again, and raised his friend, Lazarus, from being dead.] These guys heard about the miracles and watched him do some of them, and people would follow Jesus around to try to be healed. One day, they asked again, “Why won’t you tell us if you are the Savior? Tell us yes, or no.” But Jesus didn’t do that. He wanted them to have faith and believe because of what he said and did. He answered them, “I told you, and you won’t believe. The miracles that I do in my Father’s name [Who is his Father and what were the miracles?] should tell you.” After all, nobody else was running around the country doing those things, but they would not believe. Finally, Jesus said, “You don’t believe because you don’t know me, but my sheep know me. My sheep hear my voice and they believe.” What do the sheep say when Jesus calls them? Jesus said, “My sheep hear my voice and they come to me.” I am one of Jesus' sheep. When he calls me, I say, “Baaa.” When Jesus calls you, what do you say? Ask the congregation, “When Jesus calls you, what do you say?” When Jesus calls us, we all say... Let’s pray.
