Aids (pics, props, etc.)	Live flower or pictures of the details of some animals and plants.
Message Look at this flower. Do you know how many petals it has? God does. God knows everything about everything. He knows how many feathers are on every bird. He knows how many teeth every alligator has. He knows how many spots are on every giraffe. He knows every petal a flower has and every leaf that's on every tree. He knows all that because He created them and He loves them. God knows you too. He knows every time a mosquito bites you. He knows if you take an extra cookie when your mom tells you only 2. He knows how many socks you have. He knows your favorite food. He knows how many freckles you have and when your finger hurts. He knows everything about you because He created you too. He made this whole world for you to live in, and He loves His children most. When your parents were thinking about having a baby, God already knew everything about you (hair color, eye color, tall or short) and wants you to love Him as much as He loves you. Today the Bible says that we don't ever need to be afraid because God loves us so much that He knows how many hairs are on our heads. God loves you more than you will ever know. Never worry.
